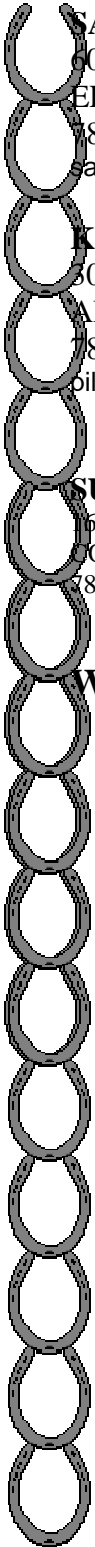

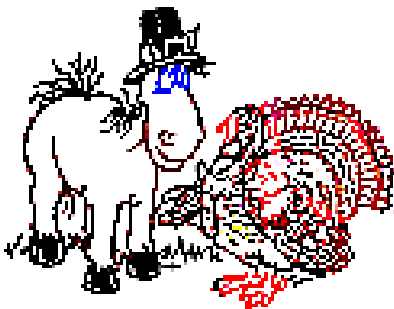
On the Officer side: Thanks to Susan Melhus for 4 years of dedication as treasurer, and her continued hard work as a point keeper.
