

STATE SHOW REMINDER TIPS!

Please read carefully before filling in your entry blanks.

If you print your entries off of the internet, please be sure that they are a clean, readable copy!

One entry form per contestant is to be filled out. **(Make a copy for additional riders - make a copy of your completed form so that you will have it the day of the show).**

If you are riding in a team/pair event, choose ONLY ONE person's form to put the entry on.

Contestants and horses are to only be paid for once regardless of the number of forms that they appear on.

Make sure to correctly tabulate your fees. If your horse/partner is being paid for on another form, please make a note of that on your form.

All entries are to be sent to your respective club secretary, and they in turn will send the entries to me with **one check issued on your saddle club account**.

Your entries need to be sent to your club secretary so that they have plenty of time to look them over and have them postmarked by **August 5th**. **NO LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED!**

Make sure that you have entered all the classes that you wish to participate in for the State Show. **All payback is figured ahead of time, so no late entries and no refunds are allowed.**

In the event of injury or illness to your horse, you are responsible for obtaining a Vet's certificate to be able to ride a substitute horse.

You must have ridden the horse you are entering in the State Show at **three** EKHA shows this summer.

All entries **must be signed** by you (if over 18) or a parent or guardian. Unsigned entries will be returned. Signature line is on the back of the form at the very end - hopefully this will make it easy to remember.

The EKHA and/or Sante Fe Trail Riders are not responsible for accidents, theft, or injuries.

Everyone needs to be ready to pitch in and help to make this a successful show. All individuals will have an assigned time to help, but if more help is needed, please be ready to volunteer.

Super Horse nominations (15.00 per horse) are due with your State Show entries. These need to be paid for with your Saddle Club check, so include them with your entry fees.
