SUPER HORSE COMPETITION RULES

1. Nomination forms must be filled out and sent in with the State Show entries (on or before August 5). A fee of \$15.00 must be sent in with the completed form. **No late nominations will be accepted.**
2. Once nomination form has been sent in there will be NO CHANGES allowed without a Vet or Doctor's certificate of injury/illness. Upon presentation of a valid certificate, a horse may be substituted for the nominated horse or a rider in the same age group may be substituted for the rider.
3. Points earned only at the EKHA State Show will be totaled to determine the Super Horse using the regular point system.
4. Horse & Rider must meet all EKHA requirements to be eligible.
5. Horse and rider(s) must have competed in at least 3 EKHA point shows as a unit.
6. Horse must have competed at least 3 times in each of at least 3 out of 5 categories.
7. Horse must compete and be entered in Category I and/or II, and also IV and/or V to be eligible to be EKHA Super Horse.
8. Horse must place in one timed event and one judged event at the State Show to qualify for the Super Horse Award.
